**WHAT:** Concerned citizens and groups from all over Adelaide will gather to protest plans for a new police horse barracks on top of this amazing biodiversity hotspot in Adelaide's Park Lands.

Mirnu Wirra is one of Adelaide's hidden nature treasures, overflowing with wildflowers, native grass meadows, birds and butterflies.

Eight hectares of sheds, office buildings, fencing and horse paddocks will destroy this living nature museum and unique snapshot of pre-European Adelaide plains.

A large crowd is expected to gather with creative signs, placards and other artistic expressions for TV and photo opportunities.
